**Pokémon Trading Card Game** The Pokémon Trading Card Game lets players collect and build decks of cards to use in games to 'battle'. Each card depicts a Pokémon along with information or 'stats' about that Pokémon.



**Pokémon Video Games** There are many different Pokémon—themed video games. Some are very detailed role play and quest games, while others are quick and simple puzzle games.






