


Polar Bears




Polar bears are large, white bears that live on the sea ice around the North Pole. They are one of the best known bears.

Polar bears have long necks and bodies, furry short ears and sharp teeth. They have thick white fur and layers of fat under the skin to keep them warm. Their white fur also helps them blend in with the ice and snow. They can hunt for seals without being easily seen.



Seals are the main food of polar bears. The seals are hunted around the holes in the ice when they come up to breathe. The polar bears also eat sea birds, fish, berries and grasses.




Polar Animals

Some animals live in very hot places, e.g. snakes and camels live in deserts. Other animals live in extremely cold places, like the Arctic or Antarctic.

Polar Bears

Polar bears live in the ice and snow and hunt seals. Their bodies are adapted to the cold. This means their bodies have changed to help them stay warm.



Polar Bear Facts

- They have big feet for swimming through the sea. They spend most of their lives in water.
- Their fur is the same colour as the snow so they blend in.
- Their super sense of smell lets them know where to hunt for seals.
- They have sharp teeth to help them hunt and eat.



Penguin Facts

- They use their wings like flippers for swimming.
- They have waterproof feathers to keep them dry.
- They have lots of fat to stop them getting too cold.
- Their beaks open wide to catch and eat fish whole!
