

Adjectives

Comparative and superlative adjectives (used when comparing things)

Adjectives can be used to compare nouns. There are degrees of comparison.

The comparative form is used when comparing two things; the superlative form is used when three or more things are being compared.

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
thin	thinn er	thinn est
short	short er	short est
large	larg er	larg est
(change the i to y) easy pretty	easi er pretti er	easi est pretti est
(words of more than two syllables) comfortable interesting beautiful	more comfortable more interesting more beautiful	most comfortable most interesting most beautiful
(exceptions) good bad far many/much little/few	better worse further/farther more less/fewer	best worst furthest/farthest most least/fewest
