

## Homonyms (also known as homographs)

Homonyms are words that are identical in pronunciation and spelling but have different meanings. They can be nouns, adjectives or verbs. The context gives their meaning.

Homonym	Examples
second	He came <b>second</b> in the backstroke race. Wait a <b>second</b> while I grab my bag. I <b>second</b> that motion Councillor.
jam	I prefer apricot <b>jam</b> on my toast. There was a tremendous traffic <b>jam</b> on the F3. Don't <b>jam</b> your finger in the car door.
present	I gave her an expensive birthday <b>present</b> . Have you been <b>present</b> in class all week? Please write your story in the <b>present</b> tense.
spring	Spring is my favourite season. I will spring into action when the fire alarm goes off. The sofa spring was sticking through the cloth. I used a spring onion in my salad.
tip	I prefer a fine <b>tip</b> on my pen. He gave me a <b>tip</b> for the Melbourne Cup. Don't <b>tip</b> the water on the floor. You gave the waiter a generous <b>tip</b> .
range	The Great Dividing Range is an Australian mountain <b>range</b> . Her singing voice had a large <b>range</b> . The new summer <b>range</b> of clothing was in the boutique.
