

## Indefinite pronouns grammar

Indefinite pronouns refer to people and things generally. They are usually considered to be singular pronouns, eg somebody, someone, everyone, anyone, no one.

Someone forgot his/her homework.

**Everyone** is trying **his/her** hardest.

Is anyone going to bring his/her mobile?

In modern usage the plural **their** is often used to represent both his and her, eg

Someone forgot their homework.

This usage is authorised and preferred by the Australian Government's *Style Manual* for official usage in government documents.
