

Phrases

A phrase is a group of words which form a part of a sentence. A phrase does not have a finite verb and does not make a whole sentence. It often starts with a preposition, eg in, on, under, with, to, before or after.

Adjectival phrases tell more about the noun or pronoun	Adverbial phrases tell more about the verb
The man with the grey hair is my grandfather. Tells more about the man	At nine o'clock, the girl entered the classroom. Tells more about entering
I saw a bird in its nest. Tells more about the bird	She sat near the door. Tells more about sitting
Everyone at the party was in costume. Tells more about everyone	At the ballet concert, he performed with great skill. Tells more about performing
