Count and write down how many windows you have in your house.

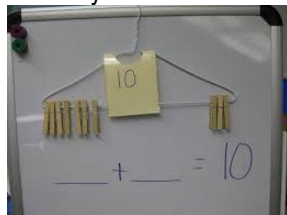
Count and write down how many lights you have in your house.

* Show your friends of ten.

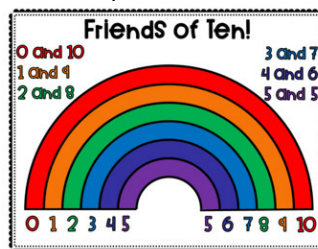

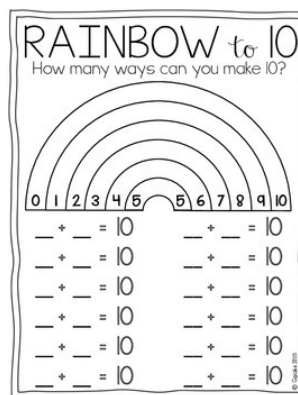

* At home, put your 10 objects into a tens frame.


